SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1309, L.D. 1772, "Resolve, for Laying of the County Taxes and Authorizing Expenditures of Kennebec County for the Year 2001"

Amend the bill in section 2 by striking out all of the last 3 lines (page 3, lines 44 to 47 in L.D.) and inserting in their place the following:

'Kennebec Valley Council of Governments:
Membership Dues 3,000

TOTAL GENERAL FUND \$8,082,803

; and be it further'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 3 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 3. Summary. Resolved: That the figures appearing in this resolve represent the total amount of taxes and the total specific expenditures authorized for the calendar year 2001. The following is a summary of revenues and appropriations:

Available Credits:

Estimated Revenue \$1,601,971
Community Corrections 396,530
