HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1314, L.D. 1778, "Resolve, to Establish the Commission to Study Ways to Eliminate Cigarette Litter in Maine"


Amend the resolve by striking out all of the emergency preamble (page 1, lines 1 to 24 in L.D.)

Further amend the resolve in section 4 in the 2nd line from the end (page 2, line 34 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "September 1, 2001" and inserting in its place the following: '30 days following the last appointment'

Further amend the resolve by striking out all of the emergency clause (page 4, lines 25 and 26 in L.D.)

SUMMARY

This amendment removes the emergency preamble and emergency clause from the resolve and it changes the date for when the first meeting is convened.
