The additional costs associated with providing staffing

The additional costs associated with providing staffing assistance to the council during the interim between legislative sessions can be absorbed by the Legislature utilizing existing budgeted resources. If the council requires staffing assistance during the legislative session, the Legislature may require an additional General Fund appropriation to contract for staff services.

The member agencies of the Children's Cabinet will incur some minor additional costs to participate as ex officio members of the council. These costs can be absorbed within the respective agencies' existing budgeted resources.

The additional costs associated with cooperation between the council and the Department of Education can be absorbed by the Department of Education utilizing existing budgeted resources.'

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SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that members of the Legislative Youth Advisory Council may be reappointed for additional 2-year terms, as long as they remain eligible for service on the council, and removes a provision in the bill that incorrectly cited the Department of Education as the entity that grants school credit for extracurricular service. It also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
