COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1321, L.D. 1782, "Resolve, Regarding Legislative Review of Section 4.04K of Chapter 4: Regulations for Licensing/Certifying of Substance Abuse Treatment Programs in the State of Maine, a Major Substantive Rule of the Department of Mental Health, Mental Retardation and Substance Abuse Services"

Amend the resolve in section 1 in the last line (page 1, line 29 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "is authorized" the following: 'as long as Section 4.04K is made retroactive to April 20, 2001'

SUMMARY

This amendment amends the resolve by requiring that Section 4.04K of Chapter 4: Regulations for Licensing/Certifying of Substance Abuse Treatment Programs in the State of Maine be made retroactive to April 20, 2001.
