Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6025, sub-§2, as amended by PL 1979, c. 541,
4 Pt. B, §14, is further amended to read:

2. Fees and other offices. Except before the District
Court, officers ~~shall-be~~ are allowed the same fees as sheriffs
8 and their deputies for like service which ~~shall~~ must be paid to
the commissioner for use of the State. Officers may not hold any
10 other state, county or municipal office for which they receive
compensation, except elected positions in municipal or county
12 government.
