26	This bill establishes the Maine Computer Crimes Task Force,
28	which is a collaborative partnership under the auspices of the Department of Public Safety, Bureau of State Police and includes

30	agencies. The purpose of the task force is to investigate and assist those law enforcement agencies in the State that
32	investigate crimes involving computers. The task force is funded by a General Fund appropriation.
