Sec. 1. State Auditor to amend campaign finance reporting forms for 2 candidates. Resolved: That, notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 21-A, section 1017, subsection 6, the State Auditor shall amend the campaign finance reporting forms for 4 traditionally funded candidates to closely resemble the reporting 6 form used in 1994 and develop a new form for participating candidates funded by the Maine Clean Election Act. All forms 8 amended or created as a result of this resolve must conform to all requirements provided in Title 21-A. The forms must be completed in time for use in the next general election after the 10 effective date of this resolve. 12

SUMMARY

16 This resolve directs the State Auditor to amend the campaign finance reporting form to resemble the form used in 1994. This form must be complete for use by the next general election.

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
