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

in fiscal year 2001-02 and fiscal year 2002-03, respectively, for the Lake and River Protection Fund. The Department of Environmental Protection will collect \$639,000 and \$1,278,000 in fiscal year 2001-02 and fiscal year 2002-03, respectively, for the Invasive Aquatic Plant and Nuisance Species Fund.

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This amendment reduces the allocation for the Land and Water Quality program within the Department of Environmental Protection by \$260,000 for fiscal year 2002-03. The total Other Special Revenue funds allocations for the Department of Environmental Protection are \$246,572 and \$835,342 in fiscal year 2001-02 and fiscal year 2002-03, respectively.

14 The amendment also reduces the allocations for the Fisheries 16 18 20

and Hatcheries Operations program within the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife by \$29,103 and \$30,308 in fiscal year 2001-02 and fiscal year 2002-03, respectively. The allocations for this program are \$29,103 and \$30,308 in fiscal year 2001-02 and fiscal year 2002-03, respectively. The total Other Special Revenue funds allocations for the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife are \$299,994 and \$728,322 in fiscal year 2001-02 and fiscal year 2002-03, respectively.

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SUMMARY

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This amendment changes the fee for a lake and river protection sticker from \$15 for any motorboat or personal watercraft to \$20 for a motorboat or personal watercraft not registered in this State and \$10 for a motorboat or personal watercraft registered in this State.

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The amendment also reduces from \$5,000 to \$250 the maximum fine for operating a motorboat or personal watercraft without a sticker and specifies that a citation for operating a motorboat or personal watercraft without a sticker may not be issued to a person who is also cited at the same time for another watercraft violation.

40 The amendment also makes adjustments to the allocation section of the bill to reflect adjustments necessitated by the 42 decreased revenues anticipated as a result of the changes to the sticker fees.
