HOUSE AMENDMENT "M" to S.P. 630, L.D. 1812, Bill, "An Act to Prevent Infestation of Invasive Aquatic Plants and to Control Other Invasive Species"

Amend the bill in Part A in section 3 in that part designated "§7794-B." by inserting after subsection 2 the following:


'3. Stickers identified. A sticker issued pursuant to this section must clearly indicate on the face of the sticker that it was issued as part of a Department of Environmental Protection program.'

Further amend the bill in Part A in section 7 in that part designated "§1862." by inserting after subsection 4 the following:

'5. Information identified. Any information issued pursuant to a program to prevent infestation of and to control invasive aquatic plants must clearly indicate that it was issued as part of a Department of Environmental Protection program.'

SUMMARY

This amendment provides that stickers and information issued pursuant to a program to prevent infestation of and to control invasive aquatic plants must clearly indicate that they were issued as part of a Department of Environmental Protection program.
