SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1364, L.D. 1821, "Resolve, to Require Further Study of the Effect and Cost Impact of Mental Illness on the State and Private Health Insurance"

Amend the resolve in the 4th paragraph after the title in the 5th line (page 1, line 17 in L.D.) by striking out the following: ", the Department of Education"

Further amend the resolve in section 1 in the 3rd and 4th lines (page 1, lines 45 and 46 in L.D.) by striking out the following: ", the Department of Education"

Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The amendment removes the Department of Education from the study requirement, therefore, there is no longer a need for an appropriation in fiscal year 2001-02.'

SUMMARY

This amendment removes the requirement that the Department of Education study and report on cost savings in the department's budget that may result from enactment of legislation providing equality of coverage for certain disorders.
