HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1368, L.D. 1825, Bill, "An Act Providing Funding for the Office of the State Fire Marshal and to Increase Certain Fire Inspection Fees"

Amend the bill in section 7 in subsection 1 by striking out all of paragraph C (page 2, line 48 in L.D.)

Further amend the bill in section 7 in subsection 1 in paragraph E in the first line (page 3, line 6 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "D" and inserting in its place the following: 'C'

Further amend the bill in section 7 in subsection 1 by relettering the paragraphs to read consecutively.

Further amend the bill in section 7 by inserting after subsection 1 the following:

'2. Notification. A fire insurance company or association subject to this section shall notify each policyholder that the premium includes a special assessment to provide funding for the State Fire Marshal. This notification must accompany the premium notice.'

Further amend the bill in section 7 by renumbering the subsections to read consecutively.

This amendment revises the bill by specifying that a fire insurance company or association that collects a special assessment shall notify each policyholder that the premium includes a special assessment to provide funding for the State Fire Marshal. The notification must accompany the premium notice and may be made in a manner to be determined by each fire insurance company or association.
