SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1372, L.D. 1828, Bill, "An Act to Clarify the Laws Regarding the Extension of Water and Wastewater Service to the Town of Raymond"

Amend the bill in section 1 by inserting at the end the following: 'This section applies retroactively to June 11, 2001.'

SUMMARY

Because the original bill would not take effect until after the Portland Water District trustee election in June, 2001, this amendment specifies that the bill, which exempts the Town of Raymond from participating in the Portland Water District trustee election, applies on a retroactive basis.
