COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "**A**" to S.P. 653, L.D. 1832, Bill, "An Act to Strengthen the Habitual Offender Law"

Amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 2 in the 4th line (page 1, line 17 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "2 years" and inserting in its place the following: '18 months'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment provides that certain habitual offenders may petition for a work-restricted license following 18 months of license revocation, instead of 2 years as proposed in the bill.
