An Act to Require Tractor-trailer Drivers to Clean Off the Roofs of Their Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2398 is enacted to read:
§2398. Clearing off ice and snow on trucks
1. Ice and compacted snow on trucks. An operator of a
truck tractor, semi-trailer or full trailer on a public way shall
clear accumulated ice and compacted snow from that vehicle to
prevent personal injury or property damage.
2. Violation. A violation of this section is a civil violation, punishable by a forfeiture of at least \$200 and not to exceed \$500.
SUMMARY
This bill requires tractor-trailer drivers to keep their
vehicles clear of ice and compacted snow. Failure to do so is a civil violation, punishable by a forfeiture of at least \$200 and
not to exceed \$500.
