COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1421, L.D. 1867, Bill, "An Act to Ensure the Safety of Maine Children While Riding in a Vehicle"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'Resolve, to Direct the Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Highway Safety to Apply for Federal Grant Funds to Promote the Safety of Maine Children Riding in a Vehicle'

Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the title and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. Apply for federal grant funds to promote protection for children. Resolved: That the Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Highway Safety shall apply for federal grants to fund an educational program that promotes the protection of children in motor vehicles.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The Department of Public Safety will incur some minor additional costs to apply for certain federal grant programs. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.'

6 This amendment is the minority report of the Joint Standing
Committee on Transportation. This amendment replaces the bill
and creates a resolve that directs the Department of Public
8 Safety, Bureau of Highway Safety to apply for federal grants that
would provide funds for an educational program that promotes the
10 safety of children in motor vehicles. This amendment also adds a
fiscal note to the bill.
