SUMMARY

This amendment is the minority report of the Joint Standing 6 Committee on Transportation. This amendment replaces the bill and creates a resolve that directs the Department of Public 8 Safety, Bureau of Highway Safety to apply for federal grants that would provide funds for an educational program that promotes the 10 safety of children in motor vehicles. This amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
