Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §7917 is enacted to read:

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**§7917. Governing board of facility**

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8       The majority of the members on the governing board of an  
10 assisted living services program that receives proceeds from  
12 bonds issued by the Maine Health and Higher Education Facilities  
14 Authority must be residents or family members of residents in the  
16 program.

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**SUMMARY**

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18       This bill requires that the majority of the members of the  
20 governing board of an assisted living facility receiving bonds  
from the Maine Health and Higher Education Facilities Authority  
be residents or family members of residents in the program.

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
