	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 2 MRSA §1, 3rd ¶, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 693, §1,
4	is amended to read:
6	Until the first Wednesday of January 1987, the Governorshall receive an annual salary of \$35,000. Beginning the first
8	Wednesday of January 1987 until the first Wednesday of January 2003, the Governor shall receive an annual salary of \$70,000.
10	Beginning the first Wednesday of January 2003, the Governor shall receive an annual salary of \$123,500.

16	This bill increases the salary of the Governor beginning in January 2003.
