_	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §1355, sub-§1-A, ¶B, as repealed and
4	replaced by PL 1987, c. 623, §15, is amended to read:
6	B. The holder of a brewery license may permit sampling of the malt liquor product on the premises:

10	(1) By employees for the purpose of quality control of the product;
12	(2) By wholesalers for the purpose of determining whether to carry the brewery's product as a wholesale
14	product, provided that the holder of the brewery license pays the excise tax on the product sampled
16	according to section 1652; and
18	(3) By the public in conjunction with a tour of the brewery's facilities, provided that:

	Currently, the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 28-A, sections
10	705 and 2051 prohibit the sale of any liquor or imitation liquor
	for consumption by a minor. This bill corrects language
12	contained in the provision governing the issuance of brewery and
	small brewery licenses to reflect that prohibition.
