26	'Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §7053, sub-§3, as amended by PL 2001, c. 316,

30	3. Requirements to be a licensed social worker on or before
32	September 30, 2003. On or before June-30,2002 <u>September 30,</u> 2003, the board may issue a license to an applicant who meets at least one of the requirements set out in this subsection:
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36	A. The applicant must have received a bachelor's degree in social work or social welfare from an accredited educational
38	institution; demonstrated to the satisfaction of the board adherence to the ethics of the social worker profession; and
40	successfully completed the examination prescribed by the board; or

The board may not issue a licensed social worker conditional license under this subsection after June-30,-2002 September 30, 2003. Individuals who have met the requirements of this subsection and have a licensed social worker conditional license issued prior to June-30,-2002 September 30, 2003, may continue to work towards full licensure as a licensed social worker under this subsection.

Sec. 2. 32 MRSA §7053, sub-§3-A, as corrected by RR 2001, c. 18 1, §41, is amended to read:

3-A. Requirements for licensed social worker after September 30, 2003. Except for those who meet the requirements
for licensure as a social worker under section 7053, subsection 3, after June-30,-2002 September 30, 2003, the board may issue a
conditional license or a license to an applicant who meets the requirements set out in this subsection.

A. Requirements for a conditional license for a licensed
 bachelor social worker include:

30 (1) Documented proof of a bachelor's degree in social work or social welfare from an institution in candidacy
32 for accreditation from the Council on Social Work Education or a successor organization;

(2) Three letters of professional recommendation
 written within one year of receipt by the board, 2 of which are provided by licensed social workers from any
 state;

- 46 (a) A licensed social worker with at least 5 years' experience;

licensed social worker, one recommendation must be from 2 the consultant to the applicant's conditional license; 4 (5) Evidence of employment in a social service delivery field; 6 (6) Payment of the application and license fee; and 8 Demonstration to the satisfaction of the board (7) 10 adherence to the ethics of the social worker profession.' 12 Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following: 14 16 **'FISCAL NOTE** 18 The State Board of Social Worker Licensure within the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation will incur 20 some minor additional costs to notify licensees of the change in licensing requirements. These costs can be absorbed within the 22 board's existing budgeted resources.' 24 26 **SUMMARY** 28 This amendment replaces the bill and extends the deadline when new educational requirements become effective to for September 30, 2003. It also adds a fiscal note to the bill. 30
