Amend the resolve in section 1 in subsection 6 in the 5th line (page 1, line 22 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Second" and inserting in its place the following: 'Seeend First'

Further amend the resolve in section 1 in subsection 6 in the 5th line (page 1, line 22 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "120th" and inserting in its place the following: '120th 121st'

Further amend the resolve in section 1 in subsection 6 in the last line (page 1, line 23 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "June 5, 2002" and inserting in its place the following: 'December 15, 2002'

Further amend the resolve by inserting after section 1 the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. Resolved: That the following appropriations and allocations are made.

28 appropriations of \$840 and \$2,520 in fiscal years 2001-02 and  
30 2002-03, respectively, for the per diem and expenses of  
32 legislative members of the Maine Millennium Commission on Hunger  
and Food Security for the additional meetings required to meet  
the final report deadline of December 15, 2002.

34 In accordance with Resolve 1997, chapter 117, the Department  
of Human Services and the State Planning Office within the  
36 Executive Department are responsible for staff assistance to the  
commission. Because of this, no funds are budgeted by the  
38 Legislature for postage, printing the report or public hearing  
costs. It is assumed that the agencies involved will be  
40 responsible for arranging for these services. The costs  
identified above are for the per diem and expenses of legislative  
42 members of the commission only.

44 The State Planning Office will incur some minor additional  
costs to provide staff assistance to the Maine Millennium  
46 Commission on Hunger and Food Security. These costs can be  
absorbed within the agency's existing budgeted resources.'


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This amendment changes the reporting deadline for the final
