_	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §3825 is enacted to read:
4	§3825. Exceptions to collection
6	Notwithstanding this chapter, an overpayment may not be
8	collected from an individual who was a minor in the household but was not the head of household at the time the overpayment accrued.

12	SUMMARY
14	This bill prohibits the Department of Human Services from collecting overpayments accrued in public benefit programs from
16	people who were minors in the household at the time that their parent or other caretaker received the overpayment.
