HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1436, L.D. 1933, "Resolve, to Establish a Blue Ribbon Commission to Address Financing of Long-term Care Costs"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 6 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 6. Staff assistance. Resolved: That upon approval of the Legislative Council, the Office of Policy and Legal Analysis shall provide necessary staffing services to the commission; and be it further'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 8 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 8. Compensation. Resolved: That those members of the commission who are Legislators are entitled to receive the legislative per diem as defined in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 3, section 2 and reimbursement for travel and other necessary expenses related to their attendance at authorized meetings of the commission. Other members of the commission who are not otherwise compensated by their employers or other entities that they represent are entitled to receive reimbursement of necessary expenses incurred for their attendance at authorized meetings from those nonstate funds that may be available to the commission; and be it further'

Further amend the amendment in section 9 in the 3rd line (page 5, line 16 in amendment) by striking out the following: "First Regular Session of the 121st"

Further amend the amendment in section 11 by inserting after
the last line the following:

'; and be it further'

Further amend the amendment by inserting after section 11
the following:

'Sec. 12. Appropriations and allocations. Resolved: That the
following appropriations and allocations are made.
