This bill eliminates the requirement that the State Board of Funeral Service conduct a sanitation inspection every 3 years and replaces it with a requirement that inspections be conducted in response to complaints or alleged violations.

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This bill includes an Other Special Revenue fund allocation of \$13,800 in fiscal year 2002-03 for the Licensing and Enforcement Division within the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation to replace one intermittent Funeral Inspector position with one 20-hour-per-week Funeral Inspector position due to the increased number of inspections.

The additional costs associated with adopting rules associated with inspections can be absorbed by the department utilizing existing budgeted resources.'

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SUMMARY

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This amendment clarifies the scope of investigation of funeral establishments and adds an appropriations and allocations section and a fiscal note to the bill.
