These costs can be absorbed within the commission's existing budgeted resources.

8 SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the committee amendment and requires the Maine Fire Protection Services Commission to examine the issue of providing protection to a volunteer firefighter from being discharged or disciplined by an employer on the grounds that the volunteer firefighter arrives late or does not arrive at work because the volunteer firefighter is responding to an emergency. This amendment has a fiscal note.
