20 1454, L.D. 1951, Bill, "An Act to Increase the Permit Fees for

24 Amend the amendment by striking out all of the 2nd indented
26 paragraph after the title (page 1, lines 27 to 29 in amendment)
28 and inserting in its place the following:

30 'Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the
32 title and before the summary and inserting in its place the
34 following:

36 **'Emergency preamble. Whereas,** Acts of the Legislature do not
38 become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted
40 as emergencies; and

42 **Whereas,** this legislation amends the laws governing pulling
44 events; and

Whereas, the fairs at which pulling events occur begin in
May; and

Whereas, it is necessary to have the changes to the laws in
effect in time to apply to the fairs beginning this spring; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
safety; now, therefore,


