
SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1462, L.D. 1959, Bill, "An Act to Eliminate Department of Professional and Financial Regulation, Bureau of Insurance Travel Restrictions for Obtaining Health Care"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "~~S4315.~~" in the first paragraph in the first line (page 1, line 38 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "projects" the following: 'servicing residents of a geographic area composed of Sagadahoc County and northeast Cumberland County'

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "~~S4315.~~" in the first paragraph in the last line (page 1, line 39 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "provisions." the following: 'For purposes of this section, northeast Cumberland County' includes Freeport, Brunswick and Durham.'

SUMMARY

This amendment defines the permissible pilot project area as Sagadahoc County and northeast Cumberland County.
