Whereas,** Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, it is necessary that this legislation be enacted as an emergency in order to allow citizens of this State to be able to call contiguous communities without having to pay a toll for those calls; and

10 Whereas, awaiting the 90 days after adjournment for this legislation to take effect is a hardship to the citizens of this
12 State; and

14 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of 16 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and 18 safety; now, therefore,

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

24 §7308. Toll-call rate for certain calls prohibited

26 <u>A telephone utility may not charge a toll-call rate for a</u> telephone call made between contiguous communities.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the 30 preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.
