COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" to H.P. 1492, L.D. 1995

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SUMMARY

4 This amendment adds clarifying language to the section of the resolve directing the Public Utilities Commission to undertake a study. This amendment removes the section of the resolve relating to the governance structure of a regional 8 transmission organization. This amendment also adds a fiscal note to the resolve.
