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Coverage under this new program can not begin until the federal waiver has been approved by the Federal Government and the Legislature has approved the program and appropriated funding for this expanded coverage.'

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## **SUMMARY**

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This amendment removes from the Medicaid cancer program the requirement of 6 months' residency, reduces the income limitation to 250% of the federal poverty level, removes the definition of "inadequate insurance coverage" and removes the requirement of repayment to the State. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the resolve.

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
