HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1501, L.D. 2004, Bill, "An Act to Phase Out the Availability of Mercury-added Products"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 5 in the 4th line (page 1, line 31 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "industrial purposes" the following: 'and except for a thermostat used by a blind or visually impaired person'

SUMMARY

This amendment exempts a thermostat used by a blind or visually impaired person from the prohibition on the sale of mercury-added thermostats.
