The Executive Department will require an additional General Fund appropriation of \$35,187 in fiscal year 2002-03 for the operation of the Office of the Maine-Canada Envoy. In addition, one legislative head count will need to be added for the position of Maine-Canada Envoy. The estimated General Fund appropriations required to fund the full-year costs will be approximately \$139,750 annually beginning in fiscal year 2003-04.'
