COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1514, L.D. 2017, Bill, "An Act to Increase the Licensing Fee Caps of the Board of Osteopathic Licensure"

Amend the bill in section 3 in that part designated "\$2574." in the first paragraph in the last line (page 2, line 9 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "\$750" and inserting in its place the following: '\$600'

Further amend the bill in section 4 in that part designated "\$2575." in the first paragraph in the last line (page 2, line 26 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "\$750" and inserting in its place the following: '\$600'

Further amend the bill in section 6 in the first paragraph in the 5th line (page 3, line 2 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "\$750" and inserting in its place the following: '\$600'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 9.

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

Increasing the fee caps for the Board of Osteopathic Licensure will increase license fee collections. The estimated

increases of dedicated revenue to the Board of Osteopathic Licensure within the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation can not be determined at this time.

The Board of Osteopathic Licensure will incur some minor additional costs to adopt rules associated with increasing the fee cap. These costs can be absorbed within the board's existing budgeted resources.'

SUMMARY

This majority amendment reduces the fee cap for certain licenses from \$750 to \$600 and removes the authorization for the Board of Osteopathic Licensure to assess a one-time fee by rule. The amendment also adds a fiscal note.
