COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1534, L.D. 2037, Bill, "An Act to Repeal the Retroactive Effect of Changes Made to the Subdivision Laws"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 (page 1, line 20 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. PL 2001, c. 359, §8 is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

Sec. 8. Retroactivity. That section of this Act that repeals and replaces the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 30-A, section 4401, subsection 4, paragraph H applies retroactively to June 1, 2001.'

SUMMARY

During the First Regular Session of the 120th Legislature, "An Act to Implement the Recommendations of the Task Force to Study Growth Management" was enacted and signed into law as Public Law 2001, chapter 359. Public Law 2001, chapter 359, section 8 contained a retroactive application clause that made the entire law effective June 1, 2001.

This amendment provides that only section 4 of Public Law 2001, chapter 359 was retroactive to June 1, 2001. All other sections of Public Law 2001, chapter 359 were effective on September 21, 2001, the general effective date for nonemergency legislation.
