2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §3107** is enacted to read:

6 **§3107. Epinephrine**

8 A municipality may provide its emergency medical services'
10 persons with the necessary training to carry and administer
12 epinephrine.

14 **SUMMARY**

16 This bill allows municipalities to train its emergency
medical services' persons to administer epinephrine, commonly
known as adrenalin.
