	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7794, sub-§1, ¶¶B and F, as enacted by PI
4	1979, c. 420, §1, are amended to read:
6	B. A motorboat already covered by a current certificate of number issued under a federally approved numbering system of
8	another state or a federal law, provided that the number so issued is displayed on the motorboat and provided that the
10	motorboat has not been within this State for a period in excess of 60 <u>14</u> consecutive days after the state of
12	principal use has been changed;
14	F. Motorboats from a country other than the United States, provided the motorboat has not been within this State for a
16	period in excess of 60 $\underline{14}$ consecutive days; and

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This bill requires that motorboats registered in another state or country that are used on Maine waters in excess of 14 consecutive days must be registered in the State.
