30	group, the nominating authorities shall select nominees who have experience working with, or special knowledge of, one or more							
32	types of school administrative unit or regional collaboratives. In appointing members to the study group, the Commissioner of							
34	Education and the Chair of the State Board of Education shall give proper consideration to achieving statewide geographical							
36	representation. The membership of the study group includes, but is not limited to, the following members:

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- Sec. 3. Chairs; convening of study group. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Education and the Chair of the State Board of Education shall jointly appoint cochairs of the study group. When the appointment of all study group members is complete, the cochairs of the study group shall call and convene the first meeting of the study group; and be it further'
- Further amend the resolve in section 3 in subsection 2 in the last line (page 1, line 40 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "State; and" and inserting in its place the following: 'State:'

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- Further amend the resolve in section 3 in subsection 3 in the last line (page 2, line 2 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "transportation." and inserting in its place the following: 'transportation; and'
- Further amend the resolve in section 3 by inserting after subsection 3 a new subsection to read:

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'4. Investigate any existing disincentives to forming regional collaboratives and identify strategies that may be applicable to removing or overcoming these disincentives.'

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- Further amend the resolve in section 3 in the indented paragraph in the 5th line (page 2, line 8 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "Institute." the following: 'The study group shall consider the recommendations contained in the preliminary and final reports of the task force on school governance convened by the State Board of Education at the request of the Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs during the First Regular Session of the 120th Legislature.'
- Further amend the resolve in section 4 in the last line (page 2, line 26 in L.D.) by inserting after the following:

 "recommendations" the following: '. Following receipt and review

of the report, the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over education and cultural affairs matters may report out legislation related to the recommendations contained in the report to the Second Regular Session of the 121st Legislature'

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Further amend the resolve by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

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Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

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FISCAL NOTE

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The additional costs associated with convening a study group to develop recommendations and submit the required report can be absorbed by the Department of Education and the State Board of Education utilizing existing budgeted resources.'

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SUMMARY

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This amendment is the majority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs. The amendment proposes to make the following changes to the resolve:

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1. It clarifies that the Commissioner of Education and the Chair of the State Board of Education shall jointly appoint members of the study group from a list of candidates recommended by nominating authorities;

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2. It provides that the nominating authorities shall select nominees who have experience working with or special knowledge of one or more types of school administrative unit or regional collaboratives:

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3. It provides that the Commissioner of Education and the Chair of the State Board of Education shall give proper consideration to achieving statewide geographical representation in appointing members to the study group;

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- 4. It provides that, when the appointment of all study group members is complete, the cochairs of the study group shall call and convene the first meeting of the study group;
- 5. It provides that the study group shall also investigate any existing disincentives to forming regional collaboratives and

- shall identify strategies that may be applicable to removing or overcoming these disincentives;
- 6. It provides that the study group shall consider the recommendations presented in the preliminary and final reports of the task force on school governance convened by the State Board of Education; and
- 7. It clarifies that the joint standing committee of the 10 Legislature having jurisdiction over education and cultural affairs matters is authorized to submit its proposed legislation 12 to the Second Regular Session of the 121st Legislature.
