SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1543, L.D. 2044, "Resolve, to Reduce Paperwork for Maine Businesses"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in the last line (page 1, line 45 in amendment) by striking out the following: "; and be it further" and inserting in its place the following: '.'


Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 2.

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment removes the \$22,624 appropriation to the Secretary of State from the bill, eliminating the General Fund cost in fiscal year 2002-03. This appropriation should not have been included in the committee amendment. As amended, the costs associated with compiling a list of licenses, registrations, forms and reports from all state agencies and reporting to the Legislature by January 15, 2003 can be absorbed by the Secretary of State utilizing existing budgeted resources.

This amendment removes the appropriations and allocations section from the committee amendment.
