The Department of the Secretary of State will require a General Fund appropriation of \$22,624 in fiscal year 2002-03 for one additional Clerk Typist IV position for a 6-month period and operating costs necessary to administer the compilation of a list of all licenses, applications, registrations, forms or reports used or required by state agencies for businesses and occupations in the State.

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The additional costs associated with compiling and submitting a list of all licenses, registrations, forms and reports required by an agency to operate a business or occupation in Maine can be absorbed by all such agencies utilizing existing budgeted resources.'

This amendment replaces the resolve and directs state agencies as defined under the Maine Administrative Procedure Act to provide the Secretary of State with a list of licenses,
