Resolve, to Recognize Veterans of World War II and the Korean Conflict in the State House Hall of Flags.

Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 203.

Sec. 1. Commission established. Resolved: That a commission is established to arrange for a plaque and a flag or flags, to be displayed in the Hall of Flags in the State House, to honor the Maine veterans of World War II and the Korean Conflict; and be it further

Sec. 2. Commission membership. Resolved: That the commission consists of 5 nonlegislative members: 3 members appointed by the 8 Governor, one member appointed by the President of the Senate and appointed by the Speaker of 10 one member the House of Representatives. All members must be appointed no later than 30 days following the effective date of this resolve. 12 The member appointed by the President of the Senate and the member appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives serve 14 as When appointment of all members is completed, cochairs. the 16 cochairs shall so notify the Executive Director of the Legislative Council and shall call and convene the first meeting of the commission no later than August 18, 2002. The members of 18 the commission serve without compensation or expenses; and be it 20 further

Sec. 3. Duties. Resolved: That the commission shall develop a design, choose a site, accept donations and make arrangements for the plaque and a flag or flags to be displayed in the State House Hall of Flags; and be it further

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Sec. 4. Staffing. Resolved: That, upon approval from the Legislative Council, the Office of Policy and Legal Analysis shall provide necessary staffing services to the commission; and be it further

Sec. 5. Funding. Resolved: That the cochairs of the commission 32 may seek and accept outside sources of funding. Prompt notice of solicitation and acceptance of funds must be sent to the 34 Legislative Council. All funds accepted must be forwarded to the Executive Director of the Legislative Council along with an 36 accounting record that includes the amount of funds, date the funds were received, from whom the funds were received and the 38 purpose and any limitation on the use of the funds. The Executive Director of the Legislative Council administers any 40 funds received; and be it further

Sec. 6. Consultation; reports. Resolved: That the commission shall consult with the State House and Capitol Park Commission to 44 ensure the appropriateness of the design and location of the new plague and the selection and placement of the new flag or flags 46 within the State House Hall of Flags. When the commission has agreed upon an appropriate location and design, but no later than 48 October 4, 2002, the commission shall submit its initial report to the Executive Director of the Legislative Council. A final 50 submitted to the Executive must be report

Director of the Legislative Council by November 1, 2002. Upon submission of its required reports, the commission terminates; and be it further

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Sec. 7. Future process; recommendations; authorization to report out **Resolved:** legislation. That the Maine Historic Preservation 6 Commission shall develop and recommend a more formal and permanent process through which future requests for adding new 8 plaques, flags or other commemorative items to the State House Hall of Flags will be considered. If ultimately adopted by the 10 Legislature, this process would replace the current process of 12 creating a special commission to develop the design and location for each new plaque, flag or other commemorative item to be placed within the State House Hall of Flags. The Maine Historic 14 Preservation Commission shall make its recommendations in writing by November 15, 2002 to the Executive Director of the Legislative 16 Council and to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over state and local government matters. 18 After receipt of the report, the committee may report out legislation based on the commission's recommendations to the 20 First Regular Session of the 121st Legislature; and be it further 22

Sec. 8. Appropriations and allocations. Resolved: That the following appropriations and allocations are made.
