Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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4	Sec. 1. 39-A MRSA §102, sub-§11, ¶A, as amended by PL 1999, c. 364, §1, is further amended by amending subparagraph (5) to read:
6	(5) Except for persons engaged in harvesting of forest products, the parent, spouse or child of a sole
8	proprietor who is employed by that sole proprietor or the parent, spouse or child of a partner who is
10	employed by the partnership of that partner or the parent, spouse or child of a member of a limited
12	liability company may state, in writing, that the parent, spouse or child waives all the benefits and
14	privileges provided by the workers' compensation laws if the board finds that the waiver is not a
16	prerequisite condition to employment;

	This bill clarifies that members of limited liability
