Further amend the amendment in the first paragraph after the title in the first line (page 1, line 23 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Amend" and inserting in its place the following: 'Further amend'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 10 (page 1, lines 41 to 47 and page 2, lines 2 to 45 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 10. Appropriations and allocations. Resolved: That the following appropriations and allocations are made.


SUMMARY
