Sec. 7. Compensation. Resolved: That members of the committee who are Legislators are entitled to the legislative per 2 diem, as defined in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 3, section 2, and reimbursement for necessary expenses incurred for their 4 attendance at authorized meetings of the committee. Other members of the committee not otherwise compensated by their 6 employers or other entities that they represent are entitled to receive reimbursement of necessary expenses incurred for their 8 attendance at authorized meetings of the committee. If other sources of funding become available, those funds may be used to 10 compensate members; and be it further' ' 12

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment removes the General Fund appropriation for the Committee to Continue to Study the Benefits and Costs for Increasing Access to Family and Medical Leave for Maine Families. The revised costs of the committee estimated to be \$4,040 in fiscal year 2002-03 can be absorbed within the Legislature's existing budgeted resources utilizing available balance forward from fiscal year 2001-02.

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SUMMARY

This amendment has been prepared pursuant to action taken by 34 the Legislative Council on March 26, 2002.

- 36 The amendment strips the emergency preamble and emergency clause as did House Amendment "A" to Committee Amendment "A" 38 (H-903).
- 40 The amendment makes further changes to the committee amendment as follows.
- It removes the language that required that the Senator
 and the House member be from different political parties.
- 46 2. It changes the convening date of the committee.
- 48 3. It clarifies the use of outside sources of funding.
