Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA $\S603$, sub- $\S5$, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, $\S2$ and affected by Pt. B, $\S5$, is amended to read:

5. Exemption from title fees. Owners exempt from registration fees are also exempt from title fees. A towing company is exempt from title fees for an abandoned vehicle when the vehicle is towed by the towing company at the request of the State Police if the towing company declares that the vehicle is a total loss while claiming the vehicle pursuant to chapter 15, subchapter III. As used in this subsection, "abandoned" has the same meaning as in section 1852.

16 SUMMARY

Under this bill, if a towing company tows an abandoned motor vehicle at the request of the State Police and then claims the vehicle and declares that the vehicle is a total loss, the towing company is exempt from paying a title fee for the vehicle.
