2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §1742-B**, as amended by PL 1991, c. 577, is
further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

6 If a proposed public improvement is not reviewed by a
7 municipal planning board, the Department of Administrative and
8 Financial Services, Bureau of General Services shall notify, in
9 writing, a property owner whose property abuts the proposed
10 public improvement before work on that proposed public
11 improvement may begin.

14 **SUMMARY**

16 This bill provides that if a proposed public improvement is
17 not reviewed by a municipal planning board, the Department of
18 Administrative and Financial Services, Bureau of General Services
19 shall notify, in writing, a property owner whose property abuts
20 the proposed public improvement before work on that proposed
public improvement may begin.
