Be	it	enacted	by	the	People	of	the	State	of	Maine	as	follows:

Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §1742-B, as amended by PL 1991, c. 577, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

If a proposed public improvement is not reviewed by a municipal planning board, the Department of Administrative and Financial Services, Bureau of General Services shall notify, in writing, a property owner whose property abuts the proposed public improvement before work on that proposed public improvement may begin.
