'<u>H. The Director of the Maine Historic Preservation</u> Commission or the director's designee.'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated 10 "<u>\$4350.</u>" in subsection 9 by striking out all of paragraph G (page 4, lines 2 and 3 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the 12 following:

14 '<u>G. Review and make recommendations regarding options for</u> establishing a state transferable development rights bank.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

'Sec. 3. Funding for public members not otherwise reimbursed for service on committee. The Maine State Housing Authority, with
existing budgeted resources, shall provide compensation for public members of the Community Preservation Advisory Committee
who are not otherwise reimbursed for their service on the committee.

Sec. 4. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

2	Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

14	This legislation establishes the Community Preservation Advisory Committee as an ongoing entity and is repealed on June
16	1, 2008. The Legislature will require General Fund appropriations of \$3,270 in fiscal years 2002-03 and every year
18	thereafter until sunset for the per diem and expenses of legislative members of the Community Preservation Advisory
20	Committee and to print the required report.
22	The additional costs associated with providing staffing assistance to the committee during the interim between
24	legislative sessions can be absorbed by the Legislature utilizing existing budgeted resources.
26	The State Planning Office within the Executive Department
28	will incur some minor additional costs to provide staffing for the Community Preservation Advisory Committee. These costs can
30	be absorbed within the agency's existing budgeted resources.
32	The Maine State Housing Authority will incur some minor additional costs to provide reimbursement for public members who
34	are not otherwise reimbursed for their service on the committee. These costs can be absorbed within the authority's existing
36	budgeted resources.
38	The additional costs associated with serving on the committee can be absorbed by the Maine Historic Preservation
40	Commission utilizing existing budgeted resources.'
42	SUMMARY
44	SUMMARI
46	This amendment decreases from 3 to 2 the number of Senate members of the Community Preservation Advisory Committee and adds as a member the Director of the Maine Historic Preservation
48	Commission. It also clarifies one of the duties of the committee by providing that the committee shall review and make

recommendations regarding options for establishing a state transferable development rights bank. It also directs the Maine

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State Housing Authority to provide compensation, with existing budgeted resources, for public members of the committee who are not otherwise reimbursed for their service on the committee.

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
