Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the 32 summary the following: 34 36 **FISCAL NOTE** 38 This bill may increase prosecutions for Class E crimes. If a jail sentence is imposed, the additional costs to the counties are estimated to be \$83.36 per day per prisoner. The number of 40 prosecutions that may result in a jail sentence and the resulting costs to the county jail system are expected to be insignificant. 42 The additional workload and administrative costs associated 44 with the minimal number of new cases filed in the court system 46 can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial The collection of additional fines may increase Department.
