	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7001, sub-§§1-G and 2-A are enacted to read:

6	<u>1-G. Aircraft. "Aircraft" means any machine or device</u> <u>designed for flight.</u>
8	2-A. Big game. "Big game" means bear, deer and moose.
10	Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §7001, sub-§30-A is enacted to read:
12	<u>30-A. Privately owned aircraft. "Privately owned aircraft" means a privately owned aircraft flown for noncommercial purposes.</u>
14	Sec. 3. 12 MRSA §7406, sub-§§24 and 25 are enacted to read:
16	24. Airborne hunting. A person on the ground or airborne
18	may not use an aircraft to aid or assist in hunting big game.
20	25. Same day airborne. A person may not hunt or help someone else hunt big game on the same hunting day that person
22	has flown on a chartered or privately owned aircraft. For the purposes of this subsection, "same hunting day" means the time
24	between the earliest and latest legal shooting hours on a particular date.

8	E. The following are Class E crimes for which the court shall impose a fine of not less than \$500, none of which may be suspended:

12	(1) Illegally hunting wild turkeys as described in section 7469, subsection 1; and
14	(2) Illegally possessing wild turkeys as described in section 7469, subsection 2+;

18	(3) Using an aircraft to aid or assist in hunting big game as described in section 7406, subsection 24 if the violation involves the taking of a big game animal; and

22	(4) Hunting big game on the same hunting day a person has flown in a chartered or privately owned aircraft as described in section 7406, subsection 25 if the
24	violation involves the taking of a big game animal.
26	The court also shall impose a fine of \$500 for each turkey illegally possessed or killed, none of which may be

34	This bill prohibits the use of aircraft to hunt big game and prohibits a person from hunting big game on the same hunting day that the person has flown on a chartered or privately owned
36	aircraft.
