FISCAL NOTE

20 This amendment will have no net effect on General Fund appropriations and revenue and a balanced budget is maintained 22 for the 2002-2003 biennium.

 This amendment will increase General Fund appropriations to the Department of Education, General Purpose Aid for Local
 Schools program by \$25,000,000 in fiscal year 2002-03.

28 This amendment also directs the transfer of \$25,000,000 from the Maine Learning Technology Endowment to the unappropriated 30 surplus of the General Fund.

SUMMARY

This amendment removes all funds from the Maine Learning 36 Technology Endowment and provides that those funds, \$25,000,000, be distributed as General Purpose Aid for Local Schools.
